




HOUSEHOLDS IN ANGUILLA

INTERNATIONAL DAY OF FAMILIES 15 MAY

This article was created by the Anguilla Statistics Department (ASD), in recognition of International Day of Families, which is celebrated every year on the 15th day of May. This article is an excerpt taken from *The Fabric of our Households (2015)* publication, which was created by the Anguilla Statistics Department. The data in this article are findings from the Anguilla Population and Housing (AP&H) Census 2011.

FIG. 1 - ANGUILLA'S NATIONAL AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD SIZE, IN 2001 AND 2011



A total of 4,935 households were enumerated in the AP&H Census 2011. An increase of 1,148 households over the period 2001 to 2011; an annual average increase of 115 households per annum.

Figure 1 shows a comparison of Anguilla's national average household size in 2001 and 2011. In 2001, the national average household size was calculated at 3.05 persons per household; however, figures from the 2011 census data indicated that the national average household size fell to 2.75 persons per household. In physical terms the number of persons per household moved from 3 to 2 persons.

FIG. 2 - ANGUILLA'S AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD SIZE BY DISTRICT, IN 2011




Figure 2 shows Anguilla's average household size by district in 2011. Seven (7) of the fourteen (14) districts recorded an average household size below the national average of 2.75 and conversely seven (7) districts recorded an average above the national average.

The districts of Sandy Hill and The Quarter including Rey Hill, recorded the lowest average household size of 2.58 and 2.60 persons per household respectively. On the contrary, the district of North Hill recorded the highest average household size of 3.13. George Hill with a 2.75 persons per household size was the district with the exact average household size to that of the national average. The two most westerly districts; West End and South Hill both registered average household sizes below the national average of 2.75 with 2.69.
