



Tourism Statistics Summary

June 2025

OVERVIEW

June's 2025 visitor arrivals to the shores of Anguilla numbered 18,992; an increase of 5.0% over its corresponding June 2024 figure of 18,091. This figure under review is registered as the highest number of arrivals for any June period spanning from 1993 – 2025. The years 2024 and 2017 followed, registering the second (18,091) and third (15,845) highest totals respectively.

The increase in visitor arrivals for the period June 2025 resulted from increasing in arrivals for both; stay-overs and day-trippers, to the island. The majority; 98.6% of the visitor arrivals, came with the intention of vacationing, while 1.4% came with the intention of doing business.

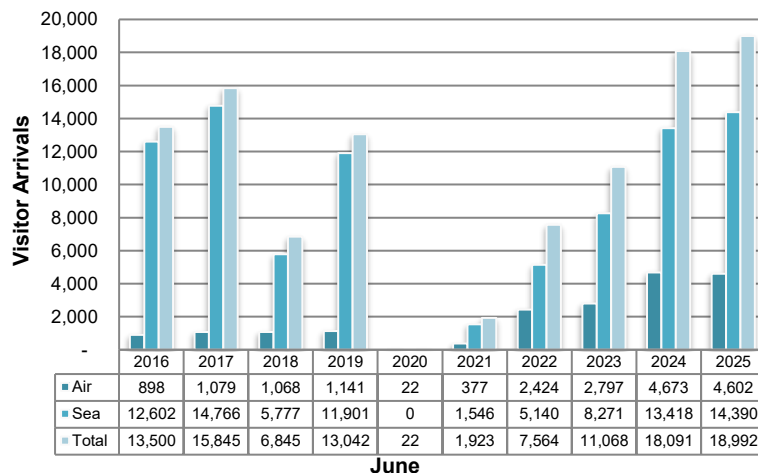


Figure 1: Visitor Arrivals, June 2016 - 2025

PASSENGER MOVEMENT

Passenger arrivals (including both residents and visitors) for June 2025 totalled 26,015, an increase of 5.4% over the corresponding June 2024 figure of 24,681 passengers.

The seaports recorded the higher number of inward passenger movement with 20,441 (78.6%) of total passengers, of which 16,752 (82.0%) entered via the Blowing Point terminal and 3,689 (18.0%) via the Road Bay port. The Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport welcomed 5,574 (21.4%) of the total passengers.

Passenger departures for June 2025 recorded an increase over its corresponding 2024 figure of 24,928 passengers by 2.9%, registering 25,650 outbound passengers.

Passenger departures via the seaports of Anguilla numbered 20,309 (79.2%), of which 16,565 (81.6%) left through the Blowing Point terminal and 3,744 (18.4%) via the Road Bay port. The Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport facilitated 5,341 (20.8%) of the total departures from Anguilla.

TOURISTS (Stay-Over Visitors)

June's tourist (stay-over visitors) arrivals to Anguilla for 2025 numbered 9,798; with an increase of 7.1% over its corresponding June 2024 figure of 9,151 arrivals. This period under review registered the highest number of tourist arrivals for any June period when reviewing data spanning from 1993 – 2025. June 2024 followed with the second highest total number of tourist arrivals with 9,151 and June 2019 with 7,787 arrivals being the third highest total of this type of arrivals.

Tourist arrivals for this period under review represents 51.6% of total visitor arrivals. Anguilla welcomed 30,812 tourists for the 2nd quarter of 2025, with a 5.1% increase over its corresponding the 2nd quarter 2024 of 29,310 arrivals. For the year 2025, January - June 2025, Anguilla recorded a total

of 68,287 tourist arrivals.

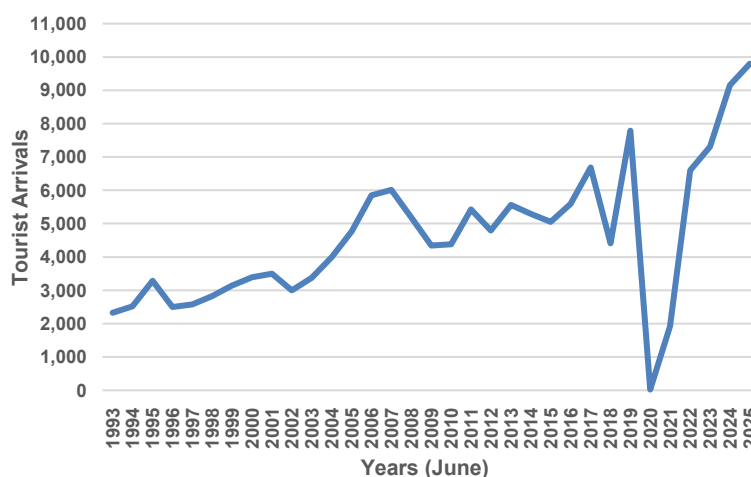


Figure 2: Tourist Arrivals, June 1993–2025

TOURISTS (Stay-Over Visitors) *continued*

The average intended length of stay of tourists in Anguilla for the period under review was 6.2 days; a decrease from the 6.3 days recorded in June 2024. The majority of tourists, 56.0% intended to spend 4-7 days in Anguilla, while 27.2% of tourists planned to stay 1-3 days, followed by 11.1% who stated they intended to stay 8-15 days. The remaining tourists 4.8% and 0.9% intended to stay 23 or more days and 16-22 days respectively.

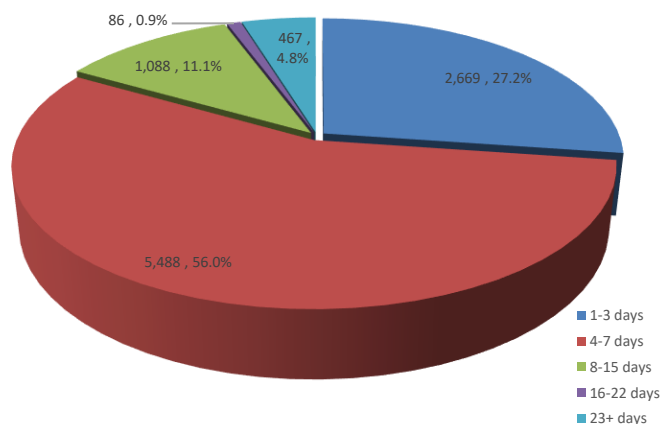


Figure 3: Tourist Arrivals by Length of Stay, June 2025

A review of the source markets for June 2025, from which the 9,798 tourists visiting Anguilla originated, showed that five (5) source markets registered increases over their 2024 corresponding figures. Anguilla's main source market, the 'USA' accounted for majority, 76.6% (7,501) of the tourist arrivals, an increase of 9.9% over the corresponding June 2024 figure. The 'Caribbean' and 'Other Europe' markets followed with shares of 5.9% (577) and 4.0% (394) of tourist arrivals respectively. The 'Italian' and 'Dutch West Indies' markets recorded the largest declines in percentage terms, over their corresponding June 2024 figures with 40.8% and 19.1% respectively.

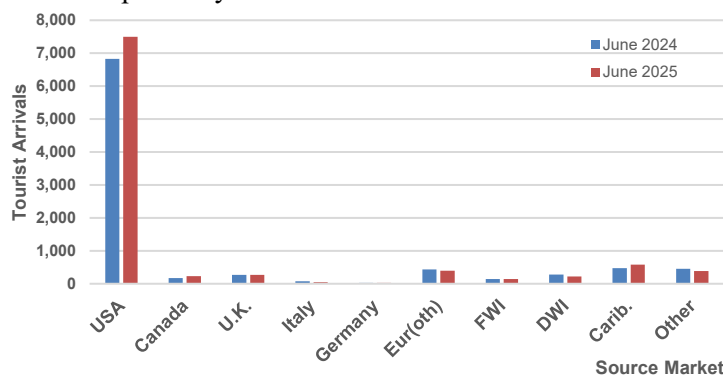


Figure 4: Tourist Arrivals by Source Market, June 2024 and 2025

EXCURSIONISTS (Day Trippers)

Excursionist arrivals for the month under review numbered 9,194, an increase of 2.8% over its corresponding June 2024 figure of 8,940 arrivals. This was the highest number of excursionists to Anguilla when reviewing data spanning 1993-2025, followed by the second highest total in 2017 of 9,160 arrivals and the third highest total in 2024 of 8,940 arrivals. Excursionist arrivals represent 48.4% of total visitor arrivals. Anguilla's 2nd quarter increased by 8.6% to 26,770 arrivals from the 24,645 in the year 2024.

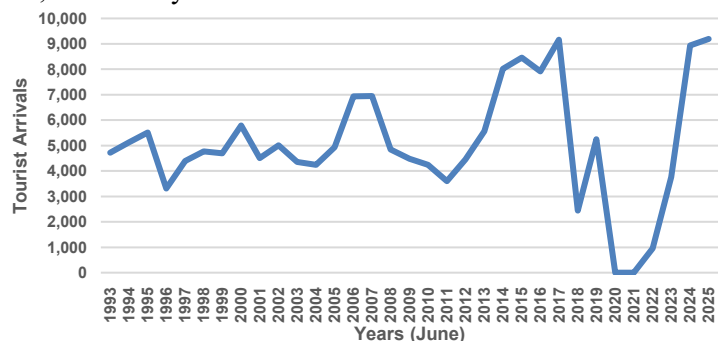


Figure 5: Excursionist Arrivals, June 1993 – 2025

A review of the excursionist numbers for June 2025 shows that all seven (7) source markets registered increases over their respective 2024 total. While the majority, 67.3% of the excursionist arrivals, 6,192 were from the 'USA' source market, this represented a 3.2% decline over its corresponding 2024 figure. The 'Canadian' and 'Other European' markets followed with shares of 6.9% (630) and 6.8% (626) respectively.

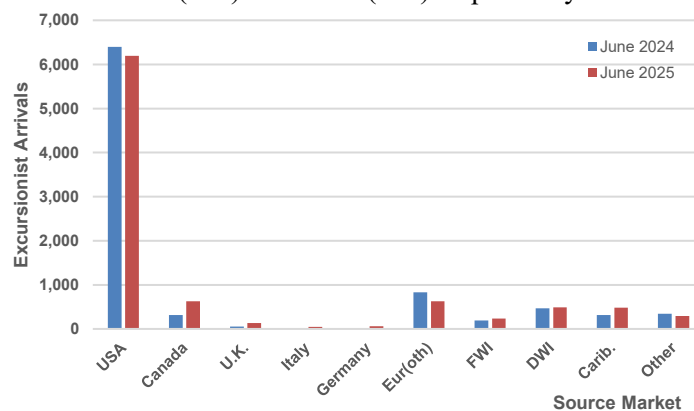


Figure 6: Excursionist Arrivals by Country of Residence, June 2024 and 2025
