During the two weeks prior to Census Day, May 9, 2001, householders were asked by census enumerators how many of different types of livestock they owned. Householders in Anguilla said that they owned 6,815 poultry, 3,722
$\qquad$ goats, 2,452 dogs, 650 pigs, 600 sheep, and 64 cattle. The actual number of livestock in Anguilla may be higher than those reported if there are livestock who no householder claimed to own.

The most numerous livestock is poultry but this is mainly due to the poultry farms in Anguilla rather than ownership of poultry by a large number of
 householders. The most popular livestock to own is goats of which there are 3,722 that are claimed to be owned. For every one sheep there are 6.2 goats and for every dog there are 1.8 sheep and goats. Cattle are the least numerous livestock with only 64 being owned in Anguilla.


Goats are more numerous in the eastern area of Anguilla, with the South Valley area having the most, numbering 611, South Hill owns the least with 132 goats. Please note that the location of livestock is according to the residence of the owner rather than where the livestock grazes.
