



Tourism Statistics Summary

June 2026

OVERVIEW

June's 2026 visitor arrivals to the shores of Anguilla numbered 26,838, an increase of 41.3% over its corresponding June 2025 figure of 18,992. The total visitor arrivals for the period under review is registered as the highest number of arrivals for any June period spanning from 1993 – 2026. The period, June 2025 followed, recording the second highest number of arrivals, 18,992 and the year 2024 recorded the third highest number with 18,091 arrivals.

The increase in visitor arrivals for the period June 2026 resulted from an increase in arrival figures from both types of visitors to the island; tourists and excursionists. The majority, 99.1% of the visitor arrivals, came with the

intention of vacationing, while 0.9% came with the intention of doing business.

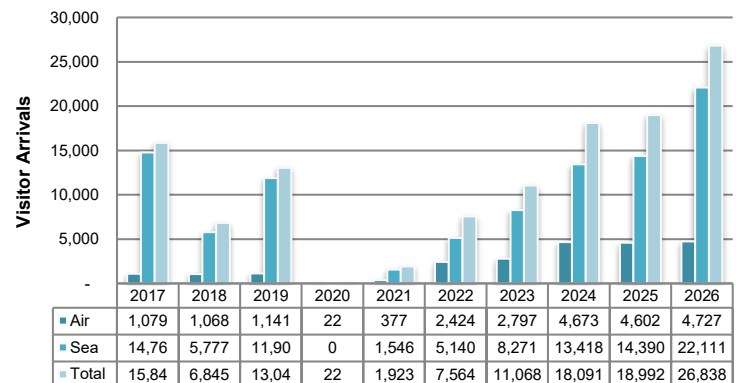


Figure 1: Visitor Arrivals, June 2017 - 2026

PASSENGER MOVEMENT

Passenger arrivals (including both residents and visitors) for June 2026 totalled 34,388, an increase of 32.2% from the corresponding figure for June 2025 of 26,015 passengers.

The seaports recorded the higher number of inward passenger movement with 28,516 (82.9%) of total passengers, of which 22,483 (78.8%) entered via the Blowing Point terminal and 6,033 (21.2%) via the Road Bay port. The Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport welcomed 5,872 (17.1%) of the total passengers.

Passenger departures for June 2026 totalled 33,761, an increase of 31.6% from the corresponding June 2025 figure of 25,650 passengers.

Passenger departures via the seaports of Anguilla numbered 27,776 (82.3%), of which 21,937 (79.0%) left through the Blowing Point terminal and 5,839 (21.0%) via the Road Bay port. The Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport facilitated 5,985 (17.7%) of the total departures from Anguilla.

TOURISTS (Stay-Over Visitors)

June's 2026 tourist (stay-over visitor) arrivals to Anguilla numbered 11,067; an increase of 13.0% from its corresponding June 2025 figure of 9,798 arrivals. This period under review registered the highest number of tourist arrivals for any June period when reviewing data spanning from 1993 – 2025. The second and third highest number of tourist arrivals for June were recorded in the year 2025 with 9,798 and 2024 with 9,151 arrivals respectively.

Tourist arrivals for this period under review represents 41.2% of the total visitor arrivals figure.

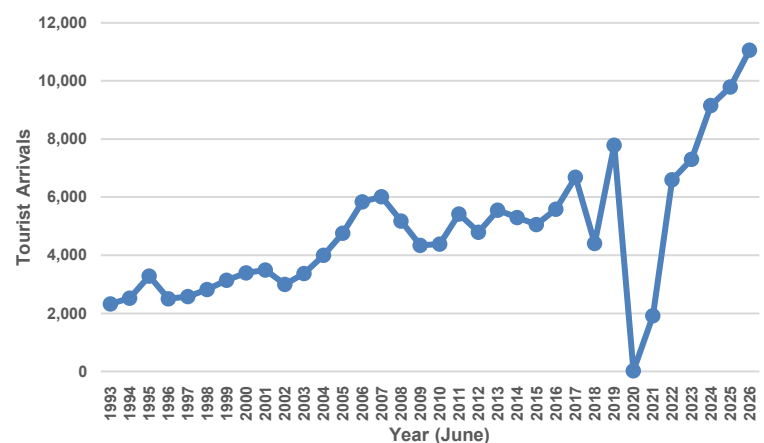


Figure 2: Tourist Arrivals, June 1993–2026

TOURISTS (Stay-Over Visitors) *continued*

The average intended length of stay of tourists in Anguilla for the period under review was 6.2 days, remaining the same as recorded in June 2025. The majority of tourists, 59.7% intended to spend 4-7 days in Anguilla, while 23.7% of tourists planned to stay 1-3 days, followed by 11.4% who stated they intended to stay for 8-15 days. The remaining tourists 4.4% and 0.8% intended to stay 23 or more days and 16-22 days respectively.

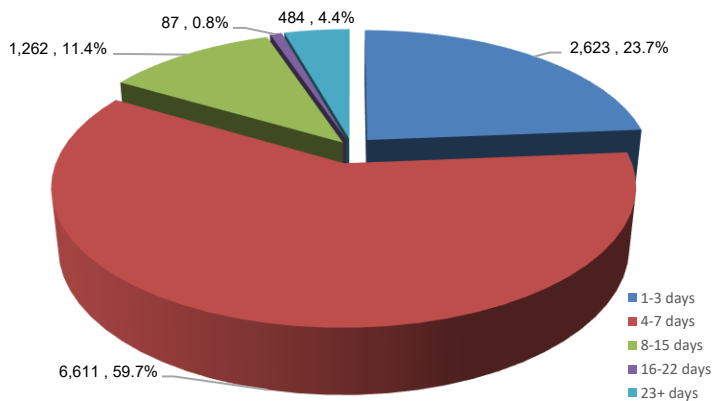


Figure 3: Tourist Arrivals by Length of Stay, June 2026

A review of the source markets for June 2026, from which the 11,067 tourists to Anguilla originated, showed that six (6) source markets registered increases over their 2025 corresponding figure. Anguilla's main source market, the 'USA' accounted for the majority, 79.0% (8,746) of the tourist arrivals, an increase of 16.6% over the corresponding June 2025 figure. The 'Caribbean' and 'Other' markets followed with shares of 6.0% (659) and 3.5% (382) of tourist arrivals respectively. The declines were recorded by the "Other European", "Canadian", "French West Indies" and "Other" markets.

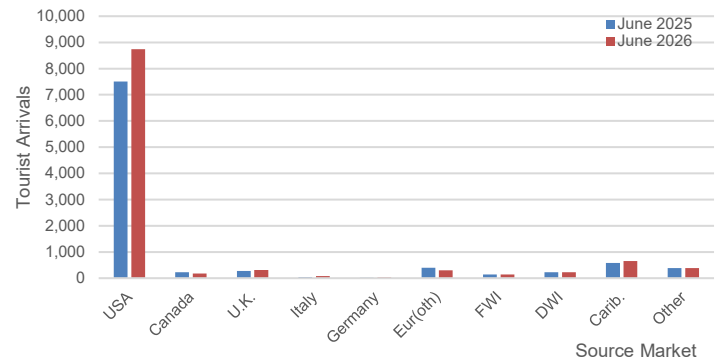


Figure 4: Tourist Arrivals by Source Market, June 2025 and 2026

EXCURSIONISTS (Day Trippers)

Excursionist arrivals for the month under review numbered 15,771, an increase of 71.5% over the corresponding June 2025 figure of 9,194 arrivals. This was the highest number of excursionists to Anguilla for any month of June when reviewing data spanning 1993-2026. The second highest number of excursionist arrivals was recorded in 2025 with 9,194 arrivals, followed by the third highest total in 2017 of 9,160 arrivals. Excursionist arrivals for this period under review represented 58.8% of total visitor arrivals.

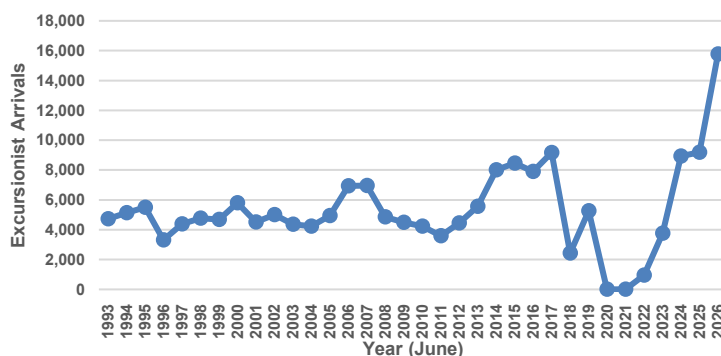


Figure 5: Excursionist Arrivals, June 1993 – 2026

A review of the excursionist source markets for June 2026 showed, five (5) registered an increase over their respective 2025 total. The majority, 80.7% (12,728) of the excursionist arrivals were from the 'USA' source market, which more than doubled its corresponding 2025 figure of 6,192 arrivals with a 105.6% increase. The 'Other European' and 'Canadian' markets followed with shares of 4.4% (701) and 3.9% (612) respectively.

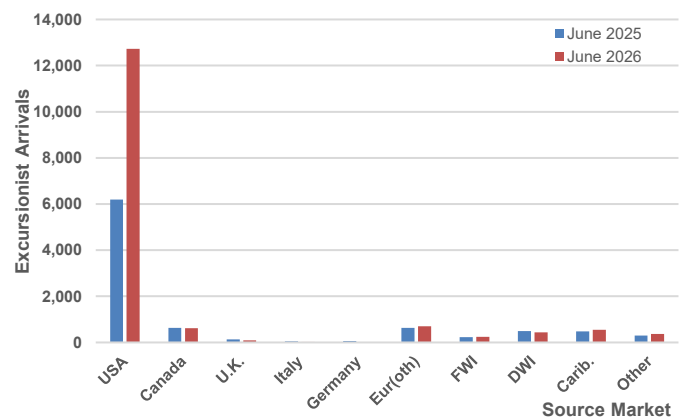


Figure 6: Excursionist Arrivals by Country of Residence, June 2025 and 2026
